Guidelines for Males (Formal Events)

- Must wear formal attire (tuxedo, suit, dress pants/shirt/tie)
- Collared shirt required
- Tie required
- · No jeans allowed
- Jacket/vest/sweater recommended for Winter Dinner; suit coat required for Prom
- Dress shoes required
- No excessively tight clothing
- · No excessively loose clothing

Guidelines for Females (Formal Events)

- No low or plunging necklines
- Appropriate and modest fit under arm
- No midriff skin showing; two-piece dresses that show skin with arms raised are not allowed (layering of a two piece is acceptable)
- Open back allowed; plunging back not allowed
- Skirts should meet a minimum of fingertip length all around (with arms relaxed at sides); slits should be a maximum of fingertip height (Long dresses/gowns recommended for Prom)
