New Student Enrollment Processes at Lincoln Christian

Applications will open on Thursday, February 13, 2025, at 9 AM.

- 1. **Online Application** Create an account and create a new student application using this link.
 - a. Select the correct class and year under "Apply to Grade."
 - b. Grades 1-12 will need to upload this signed Transfer of Records Request
 - c. If your child is currently on an IEP or 504, you will need to upload this document (as well as the original MDT) within the application.
 - d. Provide contact information for a pastor or ministry leader from your local church who will serve as a reference for your family's alignment with our <u>Statement of Faith</u>.
 - e. Following the submission of your application, we will send you a link within 48 hours to complete the online enrollment.
 - f. If your child is going into 10th, 11th, or 12th grade and plans to participate in any activities, this <u>NSAA May 1 Deadline Form</u> is required.
- 2. **Online Enrollment** After receiving an email from Jill Ballard, use the link within to complete the online enrollment.
 - a. When logging into FACTS, please use LCS-NE as the District Code.
 - b. Be prepared to upload a copy of your child's birth certificate and complete immunization record.
 - c. During this step, you will pay your <u>registration fee and set up your tuition</u> <u>payments.</u>
 - d. Submit your enrollment.

3. Testing

- a. After the online enrollment is submitted, the principal's assistant will contact you to set up testing for your child (children).
- 4. **Principal Interview** Once testing is complete, you will be contacted within 3-5 days for a family interview with the principal for your oldest child. Secondary students should plan to attend the family interview.
 - a. The principal will want to get to know your family and also review our <u>Statement of</u> <u>Faith</u>.
 - b. We would love to answer any questions that you have at this time as well.
- 5. **Acceptance** You will receive an email following the principal interview letting you know if you have been accepted and providing information needed to prepare for school at LCS.
