

DUAL CREDIT

DEFINITION: High school students taking college-level courses and, therefore, earning college credit, high school credit, or a combination of both.

THOUGHT PROCESS:

- **BOTTOM LINE:** Dual Credit involvement is a family decision and, therefore, family responsibility financially and logistically.
- **A TIP:** Contact colleges/universities of interest in regard to how dual credits transfer, grade needed to earn credit, and whether the GPA transfers or just the credit. Institutions vary on what type and how many credits they may accept.
- **A TIP:** Do not use Lincoln Christian student email address for communication/registration as those emails terminate upon graduation.
- **A TIP:** Transcripts are provided by the credit-giving institution; requests to those institutions are student/family responsibility.
- **A REALITY:** Some courses may not transfer as an exact course equivalent. It is advisable that students/parents check with specific institutions to see how Dual Credits will transfer.
- **NOTE:** Proof of passing is due by May 1 of senior year for any online course IF it is being used to fulfill a graduation requirement.
